Our wine estate is located in the heart of the romantic Mid-Rhine valley. This section of the river between Bingen and Koblenz was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 2002.

Our picturesque home town of Spay is nestled in this extremely beautiful landscape of the Loreley Valley.

The wine making tradition of our family goes back to 1678. At that time the vines were only part of a mixed agricultural farm, whereas today we are totally passionate and focused on wine production. Matthias and Marianne Müller grew the business with the continuous acquisition of the best vineyards on steep slopes of Bopparder Hamm to the current size of 14 hectares.

For our family, enjoyment of life, taste and wine have always been very important.

We dedicate ourselves to Riesling – with the aim of creating the perfect Riesling!
Our motto is: Rhine. Slate. Riesling. So we want to use our natural assets of the best steep vineyards to produce wines with a great fruit flavour and high mineral content.

Slate stopes in Bopparder Hamm

Our vines grow in the Bopparder Hamm area - one of the most impressive slate slopes of Mid-Rhine region.

Here we produce only white wines with focus on one grape variety: Riesling.

Which grape variety can better embody both: the high mineral content of our slate slopes and the pleasant fruit flavor, created in the ideal climate? For us this is Riesling! It has an elegance and juiciness like no other grape variety. This is why we are so devoted to Riesling - with a passion to create the perfect Riesling from the Mid-Rhine!

The mainly south-facing Bopparder Hamm area contains our unique single vineyards:
Mandelstein, Fässerlay, Ohlenberg,
Engelstein and Feuerlay. The sun grants our vineyards sunshine till late in the evening. Our grapes ripe perfectly, which is clearly reflected in the future wine we can enjoy later on.

It is not always easy for us to work in our vineyards, due to the inclination of 30 - 70% which is very demanding for us, especially on hot summer days.

Each location and land parcel is cultivated individually and carefully, in order to harvest the highest quality grapes from this demanding terrain, which makes the variety of locations shine in our wines.



Our "classics" are wines representing fruity, tangy and fresh Rieslings – typical of the Mid-Rhine region.

Our regional wines "Ortsweine" are ambassadors of the best origins from the Bopparder Hamm area. We want to develop the best of this natural variety in order to create a distinct character and taste, for this we use the traditional grape varieties like Riesling and Burgundy. They originate from highquality, traditional style vineyards within one location and this gives the typical local feel and sense of expression.

Outstanding Rieslings of a vintage variety from our wine estate are called "EDITION MM". This name reflects the initials of Marianne and Matthias Müller and presents their personal idea of a high class Mid-Rhine Riesling – a true signature wine.

Große Lage is the designation for the highest quality German vineyards. The vineyards are precisely demarcated by parcel and spent the grapes for the top level wines in our winery. Wines notable for their individual character and ability to express the essence of their vineyard of origin. We call dry wines from these vineyards VDP.GROSSES GEWÄCHS.

The steep slopes at **Mandelstein** are south-southeast facing. There you will find many of our steepest vineyards with a gradient of up to 70%. The combination of intense sunshine, deep-reaching roots and dry, strong weathered slate soils is unique and certainly responsible for the mineral rich, gentle spiciness and long-lasting flavor of the Rieslings from here.

The wines from the single vineyard Fässerlay are very different to the wines from the other single vineyards in the Bopparder Hamm area. This south-east facing site with an average inclination of 40-50% and slightly acidic slate soils, produce fresh and light-footed Rieslings.

An der Rabenlei is the most prized vineyard at the Ohlenberg site. The grapes from this small single vineyard always had an enormous range of flavours and complexity – so we harvest and produce them separately. It is a location that was added to the portfolio in 2016.

Optimal ripening of the grapes is guaranteed by the southern exposure of the vines, the river Rhine as a temperature regulator and lots of slate stones which work like a heat accumulator, therefore ideal ripening of grapes is guaranteed.

All this combined with quartz rock on stony slate are the prerequisites for producing juicy, fruity and spirited wines from the **Ohlenberg**.

The south facing vista of **Engelstein** makes it the earliest single vineyard in the Bopparder Hamm area. There our grapes enjoy sunshine till late in the evening.

The roots of the vines are able to grow very deep through the slate, but also through layers of volcanic rock. The intensive spicy aromas and the fine freshness are the typical characteristics for our Rieslings from Engelstein.
